TWYFORD ABBEY ROAD DUAL USE PARKING PLACE

The Ealing (Parking Places) (Pay and Display) (West Twyford) Order 200*

The Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area)

(Amendment No. *) Order 200*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Ealing (Parking Places) (Pay and Display) (West Twyford) Order 200* would be to:
 - (a) convert the permit parking place in Twyford Abbey Road to provide a dual use permit and 2 hour maximum stay "pay and display" parking place operating between the hours of 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
 - (b) provide that passenger vehicles, goods carrying vehicles, motorcycles and disabled persons vehicles may be left in the parking place and that with the exception of motorcycles and disabled persons vehicles, either a valid West Twyford Y zone permit or visitors voucher or a parking ticket purchased from a parking ticket machine must be displayed whilst parked in the parking place;
 - (c) provide that no vehicle may return to the parking place for a period of at least one hour;
 - (d) provide that the charges for parking in the pay and display" parking place would be 30 pence for each period of thirty minutes up to maximum of £1.20.
3. The general effect of the Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. *) Order 200* would be to amend existing waiting restrictions so that they apply between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays in the length of Twyford Abbey Road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
4. Copies of the Orders, and of other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, can be inspected between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Monday to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made or the Council decide not to make the Orders at the Mouchel Group, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST.

6. Any objections or other representation about either of the proposed Orders should be sent in writing to the Mouchel Group, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST until 31st December 2008. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.
